## **Dress Code**

## Please review our updated Dress Code for the 2022-2023 school year.

Gesu Catholic School has an established uniform code for students in grades 1-8. Gesu uniforms may be purchased at Schoolbelles.

#### Kindergarten:

 There is no uniform for kindergarten. Appropriate school attire is recommended. Please be sure to dress appropriately for the weather.

### **ALL STUDENTS (Grades 1-8)**

#### Polo Shirts:

- Solid Red, Navy Blue/Sky Blue, Gray, Black, White, Yellow or Green.
- Polo shirts must have either the GESU School Logo (purchased from Schoolbelles) OR NO OTHER VISIBLE LOGO.

#### **Sweaters and Fleece Jackets:**

- Solid Red, Navy Blue/Sky Blue, Gray, Black, White, Yellow or Green.
- Sweaters/Fleece Jackets must have either the GESU School Logo (purchased from Schoolbelles) OR NO OTHER VISIBLE LOGO.

### Skirt, Jumper, or Pants/Shorts:

- <u>Skirt/Jumper must be purchased from Schoolbelles</u> (two inches above the top of the knee or longer).
- Pants can be navy blue, khaki, or black (no leggings, no jeans, no saggy slacks, no rivets) worn at the waist.

Fleece Pants: Any colors or patterns are permitted on cold weather days with the uniform, as students travel to and from school or for outdoor recess, as long as they are removed when they enter their classroom.

Socks: Solid any color.

## Shoes:

Tennis Shoes (ankle length) or dress shoes. Boots should only be worn during the winter months and students should only
wear them when outside during recess, otherwise boots should not be worn during school.

Hair: solid color, clean, neat and out of eyes.

Headbands: No bandanas and must be no larger than an inch thick.

Purses: Purses are not allowed during school hours. Teachers will discuss proper storage of femine products with students.

Jawelry:

- No excessive jewelry
- Post earrings only.

## **Dress-Down Days Appropriate Dress Includes:**

- T-shirts, Jerseys or sweatshirts- without alcohol, drug, or gang logos no profanity shirts must cover the armpits and midriffs
- Jeans, khakis, sweatpants or shorts (fingertip rule)- without holes, slit seams, lace insets in good repair.
- Socks must be worn with shoes; no sandals, clogs, or backless shoes.
- No skirts or mini dresses
- Hats and other head coverings- Hats must be removed upon entering the building EVERYDAY.

School officials reserve the right to not allow students into class if they deem the attire inappropriate. Students will be asked to call home for parents to bring appropriate clothing. If you are not sure, always bring your school clothes to have something to change into on days when there is a dress down.
